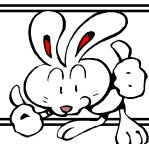
Red Nose Day

Easter Activity Camp

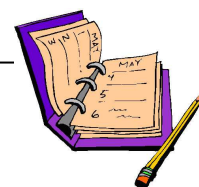
Fit for Sport will be running activity camps
