Dear Year 6 Parents/Carers,

Your child may have informed you that last week they started doing a lunch time duty. I have introduced 'Year 6 Jobs' for 20 mins of a lunch time, 2-3 times per week for every pupil. This is to raise the profile of Year 6 pupils being at the top of the school; giving them the opportunity and responsibility of setting an example of our high expectations to younger pupils. You will have the opportunity to ask questions regarding the tests in order to support your child as effectively as possible. We will also discuss how their results will be reported to you.
