

# Progression in Art and Design




## **Year 1 artists will be able to...**

Begin to explore different techniques involved in drawing, such as shading thick/thin lines  
Begin to use a variety of brushes to see what happens  
Use a variety of materials for sculpting and experiment with joining and constructing



## **Year 2 artists will be able to...**

Use a range of different materials to draw with, such as pencils, felt tips, charcoal, crayons, chalk and pastels  
Recognise the primary colours and experiment with mixing paints to understand tone and secondary colours




## **Year 3 artists will be able to...**

Demonstrate knowledge of a range of techniques for developing tone, texture, light and shadow  
Begin to experiment with colour for effect and mood




## **Year 4 artists will be able to...**

Develop their understanding of sculpture, including adding expression through texture  
Sort and arrange materials with purpose to create effect  
Develop their weaving and colour fabric skills including the skill of stitching



## **Year 5 artists will be able to...**

Use a variety of drawing tools, including new techniques such as creating perspective  
Use the language of colour accurately and use inspiration from natural and non-natural works to create a colour palette



## **Year 6 artists will be able to...**

Produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences  
Demonstrate proficiency in drawing, painting, sculpture and other art, craft and design techniques  
Evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design  
Know about great artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms
