
Year 1 musicians will be able to...

Explain what music is
Identify what makes music
Define key musical terms
Explain what music does and how it makes us feel




Year 2 musicians will be able to...

Layer sounds using a variety of instruments
Recognising the sounds and effects of instruments played individually and together




Year 3 musicians will be able to...

Recognise and use musical notation
Respond to the role of music conductors/signals
Manipulate sounds of pitched instruments




Year 4 musicians will be able to...

Identify key music composers – past and present
Explore and compare some musical styles
Read and write using graphic notation



Year 5 musicians will be able to...

Refine accuracy, fluency, control and expression as part of group performances
Make conscious choices of instruments based on their sound
Synchronise music
Create increasingly complex graphic scores, including musical elements, such as duration



Year 6 musicians will be able to...

Understand the relationship between sounds
Make appropriate choices of instrument based on intention
Demonstrate increasingly detailed knowledge of graphic notation
Perform with increasing accuracy, fluency, expression and control
Refine skills and apply knowledge acquired in Year 1 to Year 5
