
Year 1 geographers will be able to...

Describe a journey on a map of the local area using simple compass directions




Year 2 geographers will be able to...

Describe the human and physical environments within their local area




Year 3 geographers will be able to...

Describe aspects of physical geography including key features including climate & coasts




Year 4 geographers will be able to...
