In accordance with the requirements of the National Curriculum (2014), our pupils are taught to:

- ✓ Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- ✓ Use a range of strokes effectively
- ✓ Perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.'

Our Year 5 cohort visit Smethwick Swimming Baths weekly for the duration of the academic year.

Swimming sessions at Smethwick Swimming Baths are delivered by a minimum of two qualified swimming instructors. This means that pupils can be taught in smaller groups, ensuring pupils make good progress from their different starting points.

Swimming sessions are supervised by the Year 5 class teacher and a school-based first aider (typically a member of support staff).
