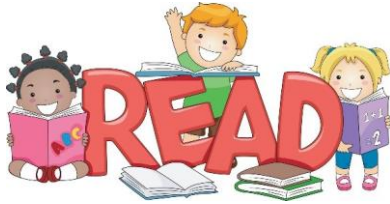
As well as supporting Athletes, a percentage of the sponsorship money will be used in school to support our children.
